Welcome	Scott Nelson	Welcome and introductions were made.	
CSA Operations	Scott Nelson	<p>Scott provided an overview the CSA activities. For those who prefer to view the slides, please skip this section and visit <a href="http://www.coloradostroke.org">www.coloradostroke.org</a>, November 2010 CSA update.</p> <p>Operations: Site visits are in progress. 1 visit per year per hospital. During site visit the trend reports are reviewed, GWTG payment is delivered, update on CSA provided.</p> <p>Letter of Intent: CSA has a LOI for participating hospitals extending participation to June 2011. Payments are in progress.</p> <p>Hospital status: There are 38 hospitals are participating. More than 17,000 cases have been entered into GWTG-Stroke for Colorado.</p> <p>Budget/grant updates: CSA grant is for July 2010-June 2011, grant amount of \$149,000. It is anticipated that new CSA GWTG-Stroke payments will be: CAH=\$525, Basic/JC=\$725, site visits, 2 trend report printings, and CSA business meetings will be included. As of 11/18/2010, the CCPD has not published anything about the upcoming 2011/2012 grant cycle. AHA is increasing the cost of GWTG starting Jan.1 , 2011. Please contact Julie Blakey if you would like more information.</p> <p>Publication: CSA has edited JNN manuscript and resubmitted to JNN for review. Dr Cumber's in-hospital manuscript has been accepted by Stroke for publication. Publication date pending.</p> <p>CCPD Q1 progress report due October 15, 2010 – this has been submitted. Q2 is due in January 2011.</p> <p>Mentor meetings: Occur on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday of every-other month following CSA business meetings, 915 – 1015 am. The CSA rural mentor meeting will occur on the same 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday, from 1015 – 1045 AM.</p>	
Data	Dr. Don Smith	<p>Dr. Smith reviewed the 4 submissions by CSA to the ISC. All 4 were accepted, 3 as poster presentations, 1 as a presentation. Dr. Smith will be attending the ISC 2011 in Los Angeles in February.</p> <p>Dr. Smith gave an overview of the data as of November 9. There are more than 17,000 patients in the database. More than 1200 additional patients are in the database, but have incomplete data.</p>	

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Strategic planning	Scott Nelson	<p>Dr. Smith was contacted by a colleague at Stanford looking to expand a stroke study. He will continue to look at this as an opportunity for future data work.</p> <p>Transition update:          Scott stepped in as the Interim Director of the CSA on Oct. 19. The office was moved from Paul's to Scott's residence. Scott was able to spend some valuable time with Paul for training. Paul provided an outstanding transition document. Scott expressed his gratitude at the opportunity and thanked Paul for his work with the CSA and support during the transition.</p>
